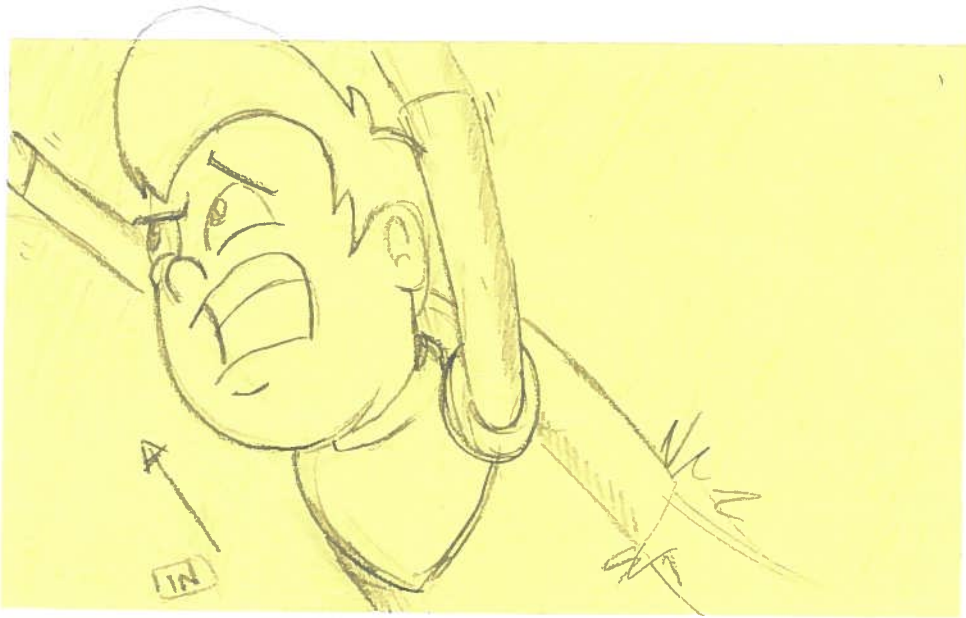
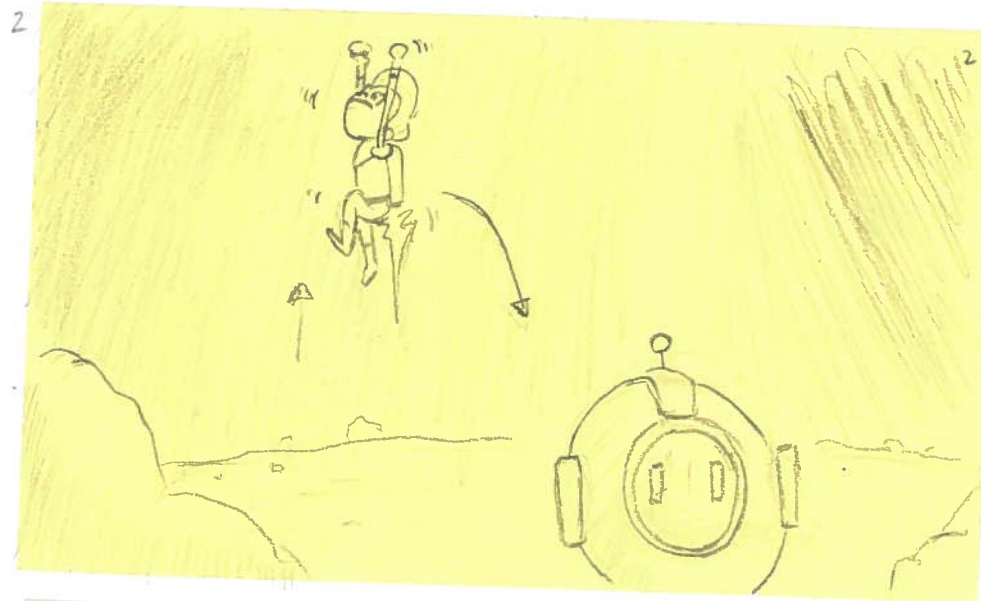

A.I.: "The battery's dead then?"

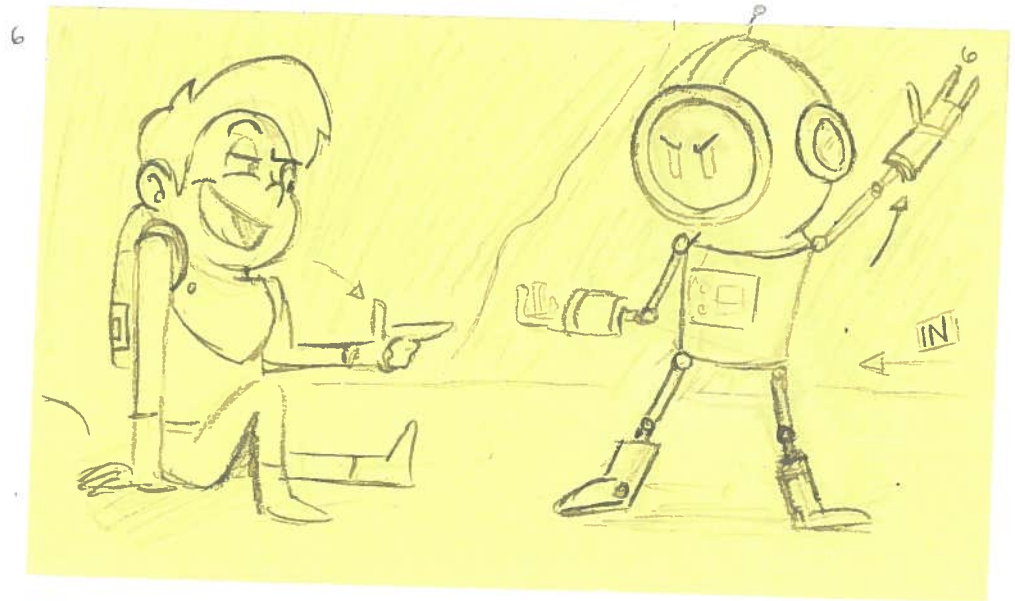
Ham: "Yup, all outta juice."

Ham sits on the ground recovering from his fall.



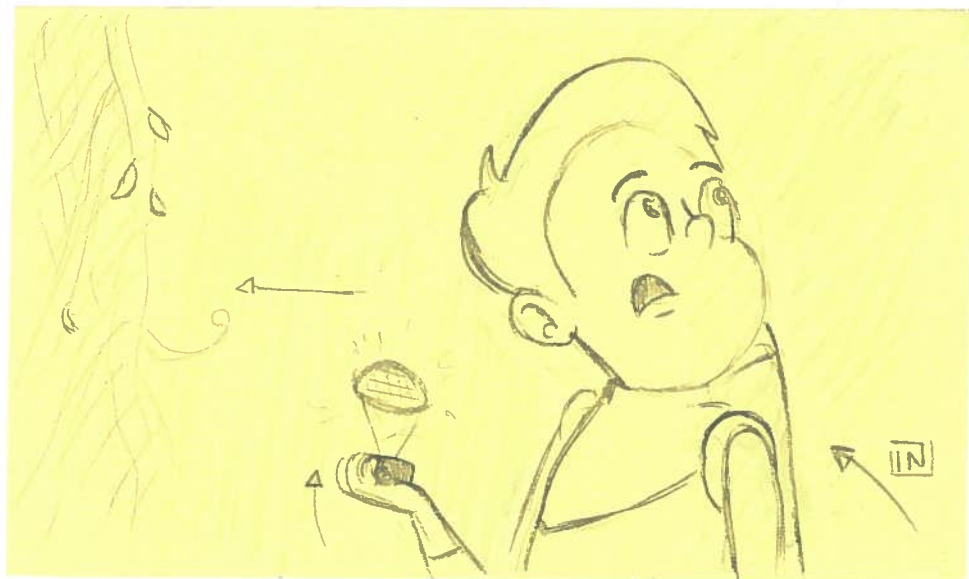
A.I.: "More time?! <sup>Ham</sup> We've already been down here all day, and haven't found anything."

HAM: There has to be something to discover down here. I know it!

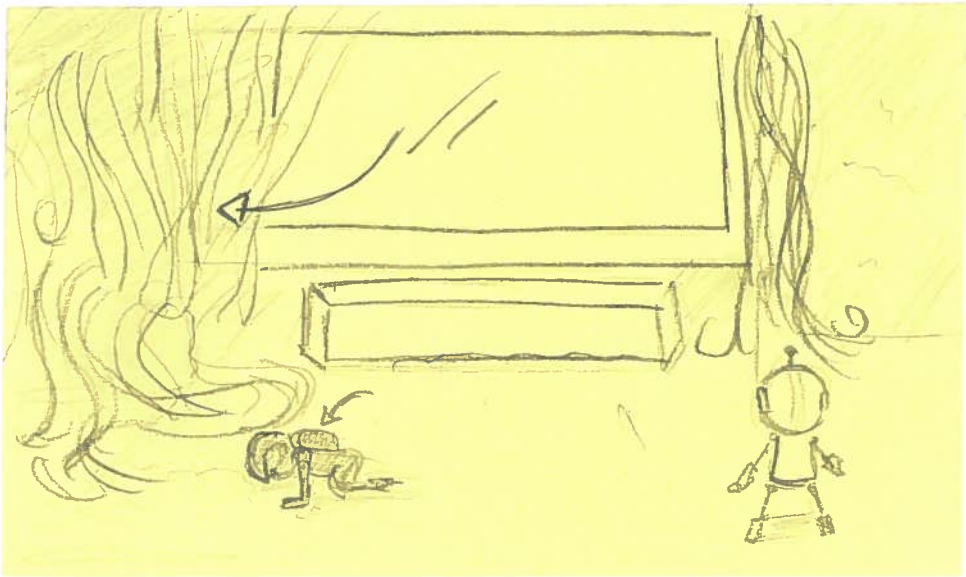
Ham rises into frame and walks SL. He pulls up a holo compass. As he walks, he trips and falls.

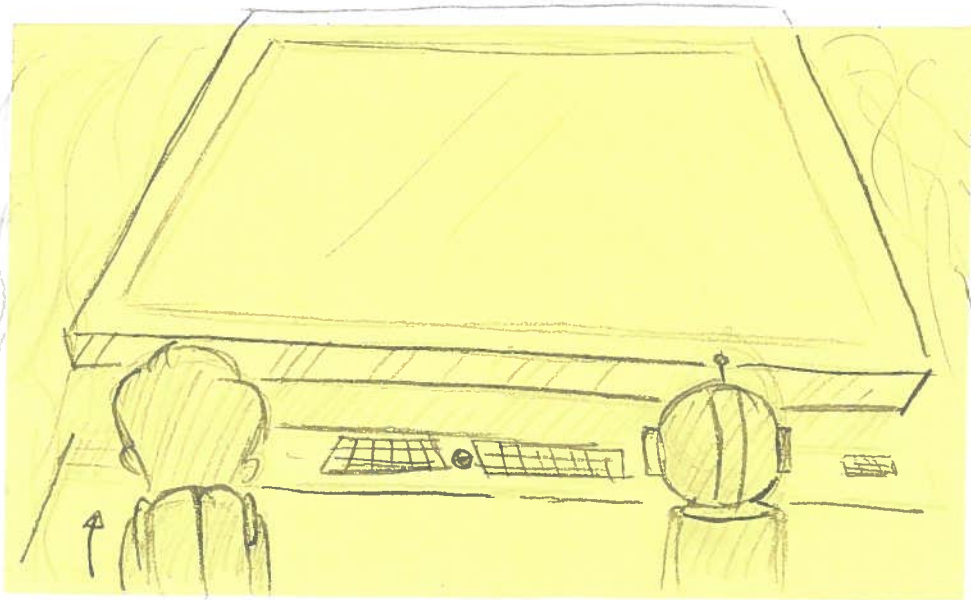


As he walks, Ham trips and falls. He pulls some vines down as he falls

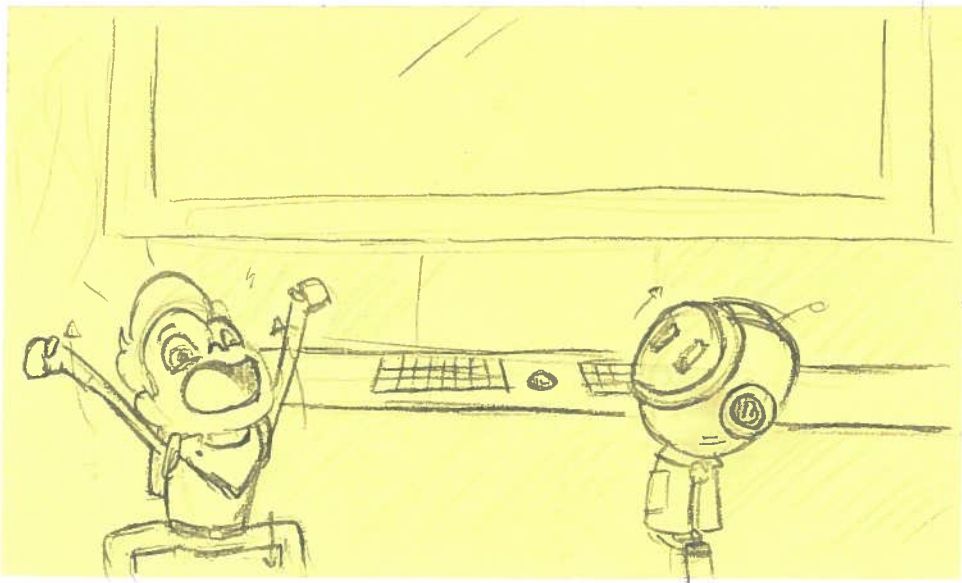
Ham + A.I. move in to have

Ham: (whisper) "Discoveryyy..."

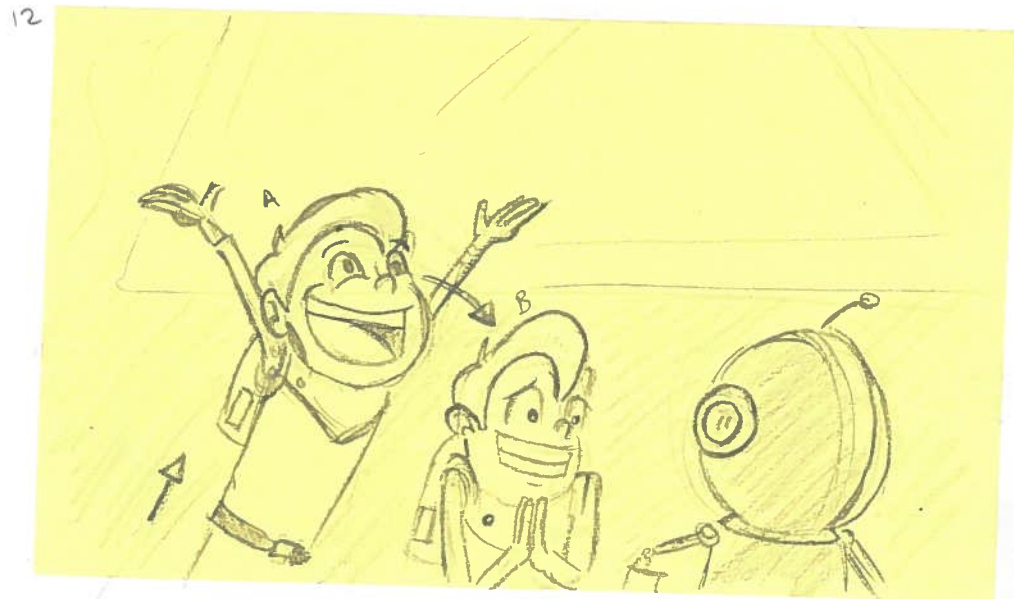
Push in to CU of Ham. His

An ancient one."

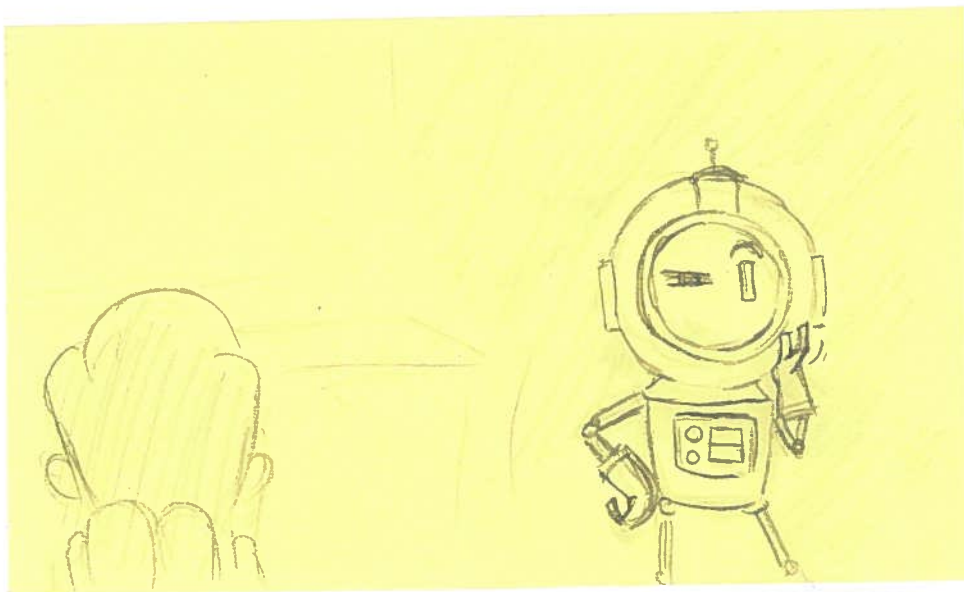
Ham starts getting excited  
about the new discovery.



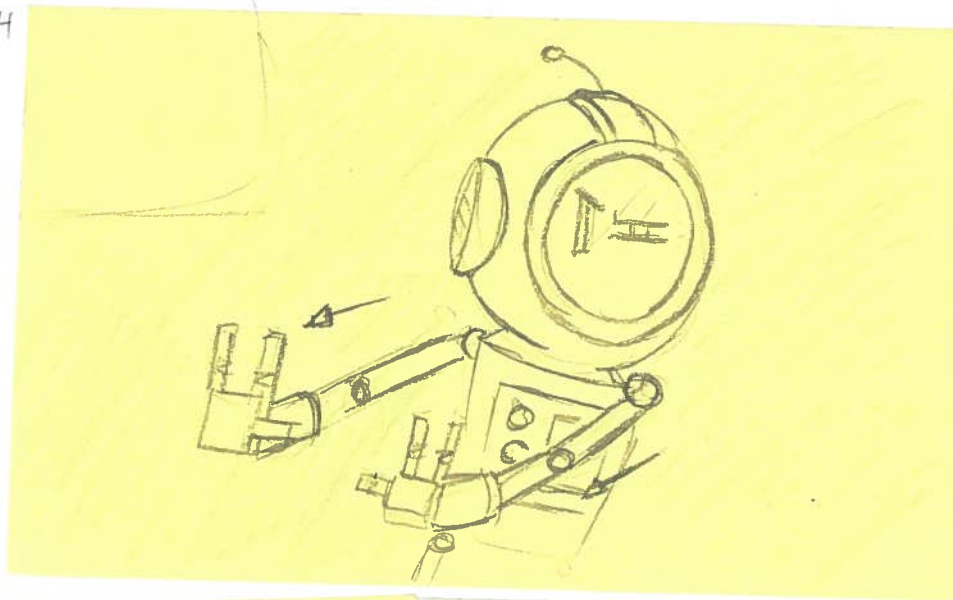
Ham: "See? SEE!!? This is exactly

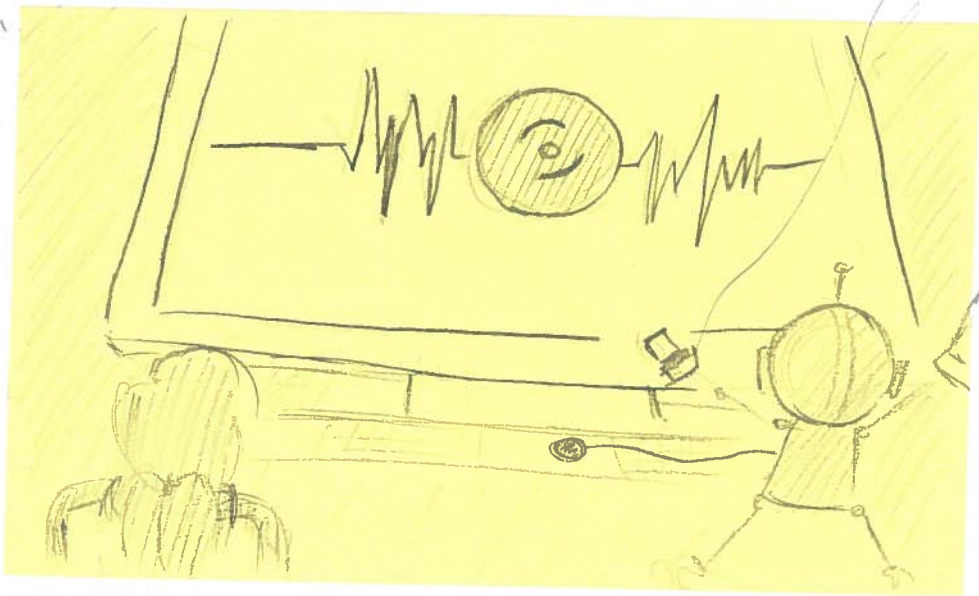


HAM: was it something I said?

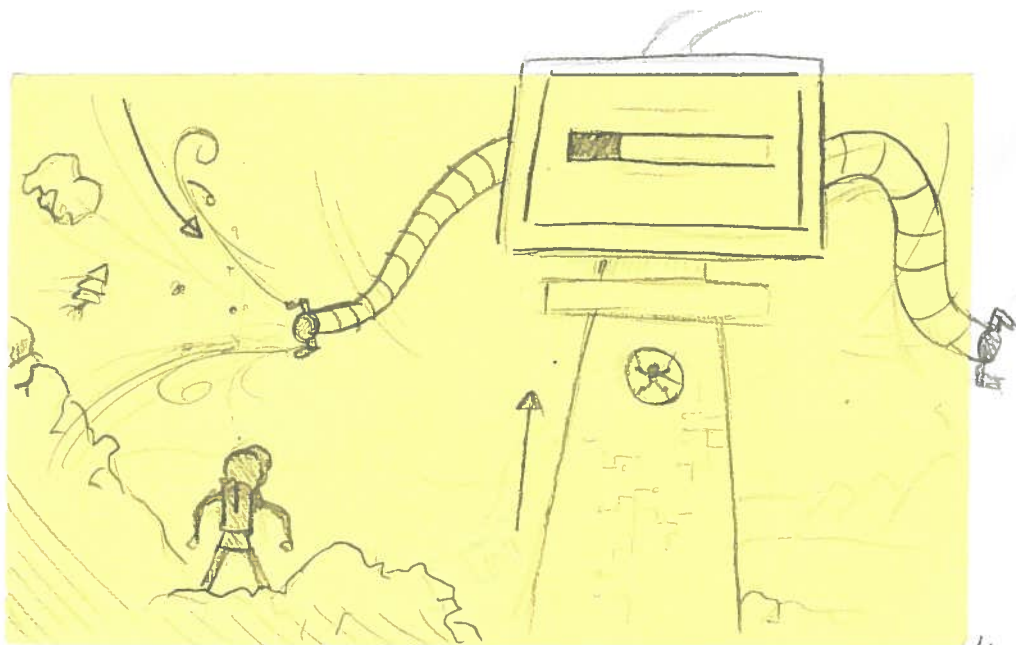
Up shot of CPU

Ext. Day.

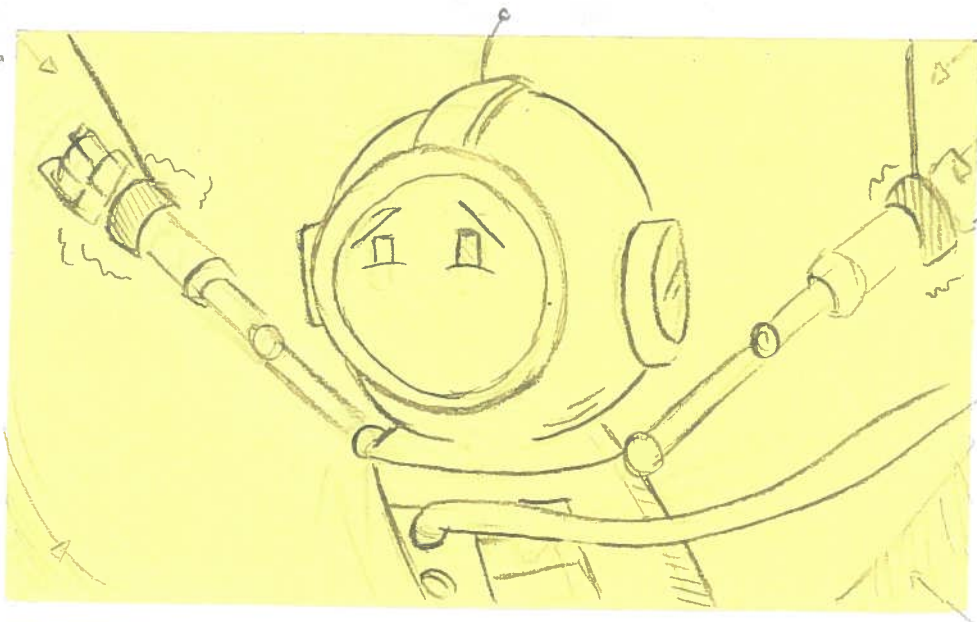

Ham dives behind a rock to avoid getting sucked up by the CPU tentacle

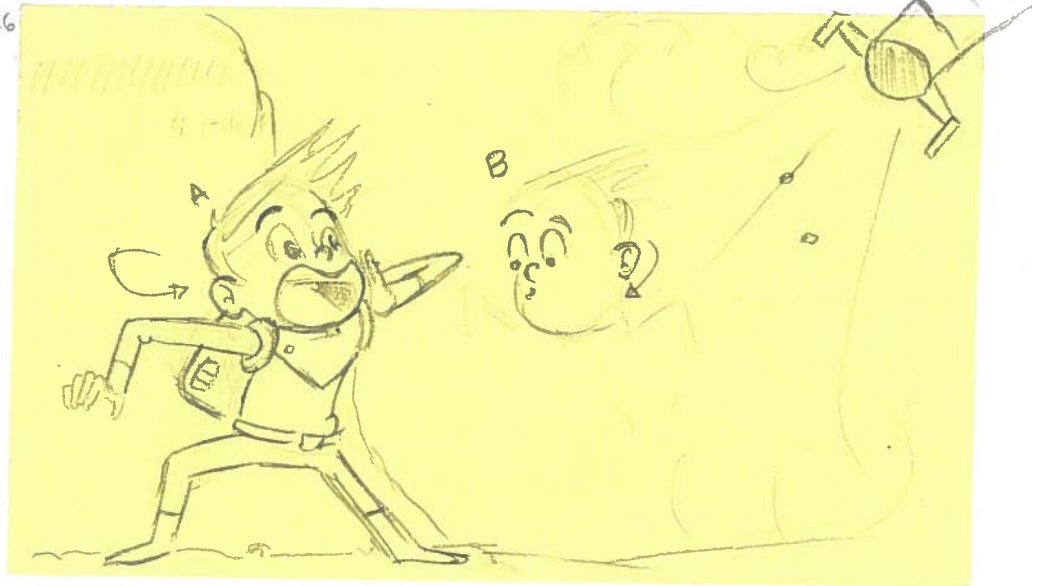

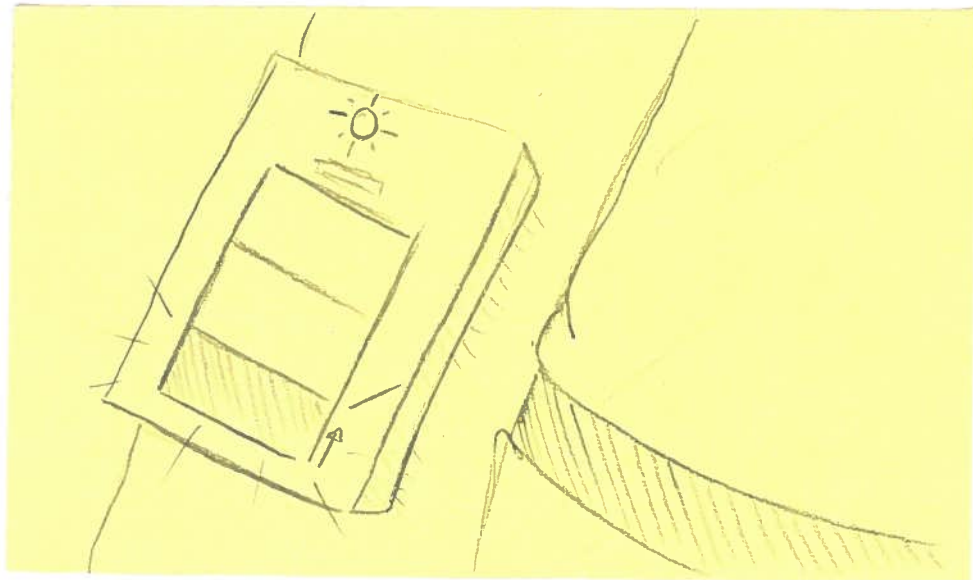
HAM: I can't, remember?! There's not enough Sun... light...

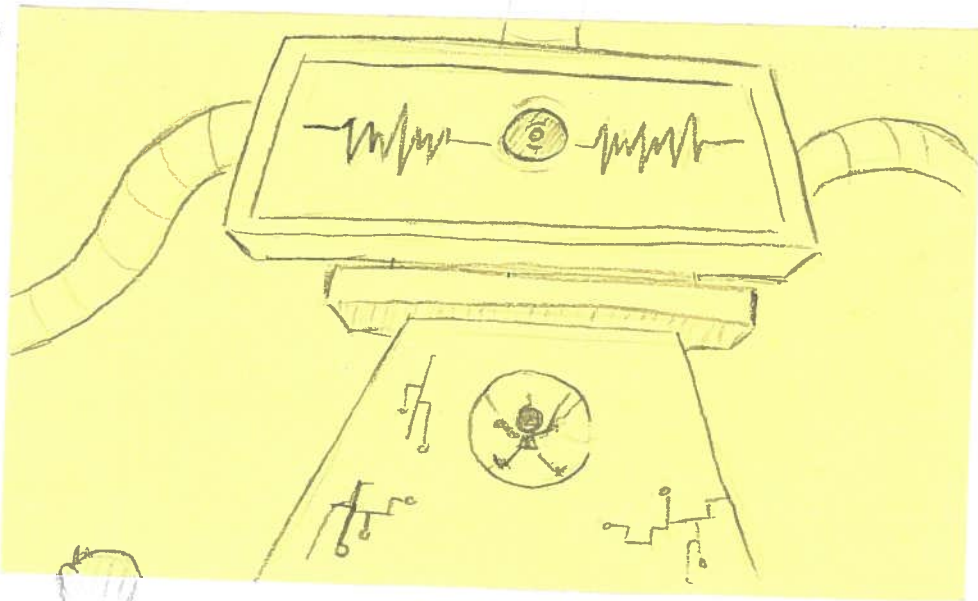

Ham yells @ the CPU to get its attention. He dodges tentacle attacks as he does so.

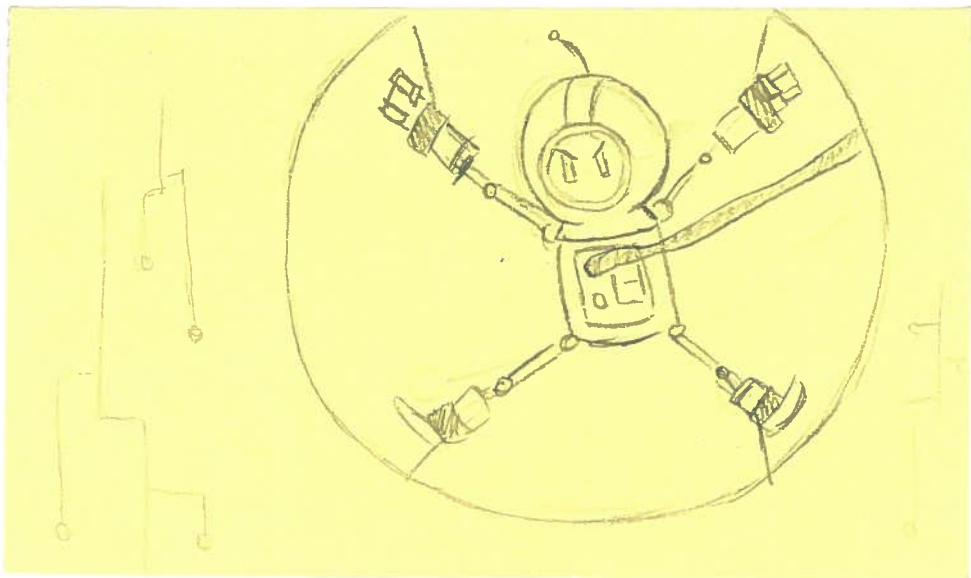




CPU: Assimilation Paused.

 CPU stops all movement and assimilation for a moment.

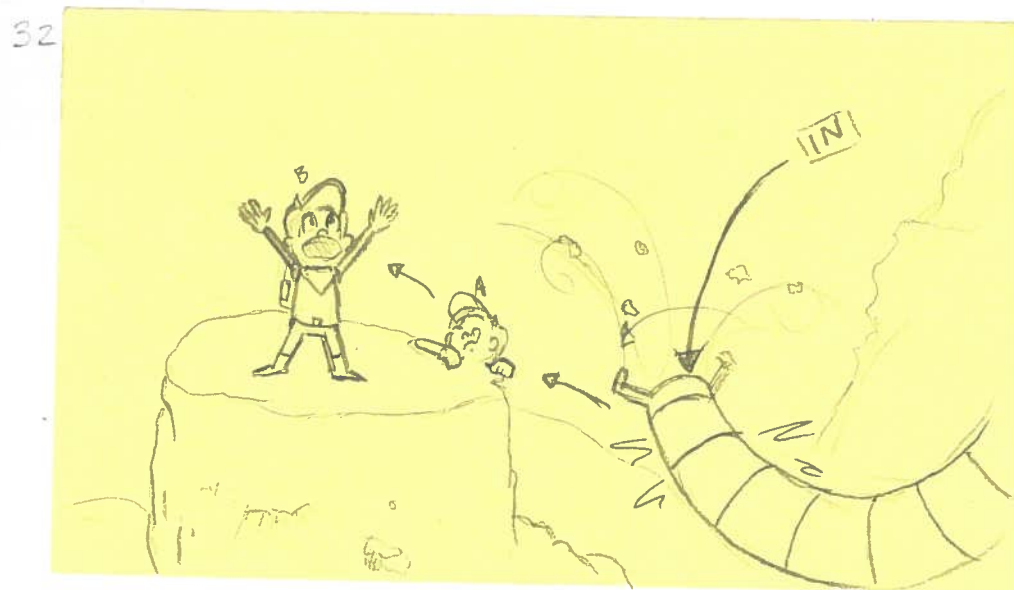


CPU: Assimilation continued

down to Ham

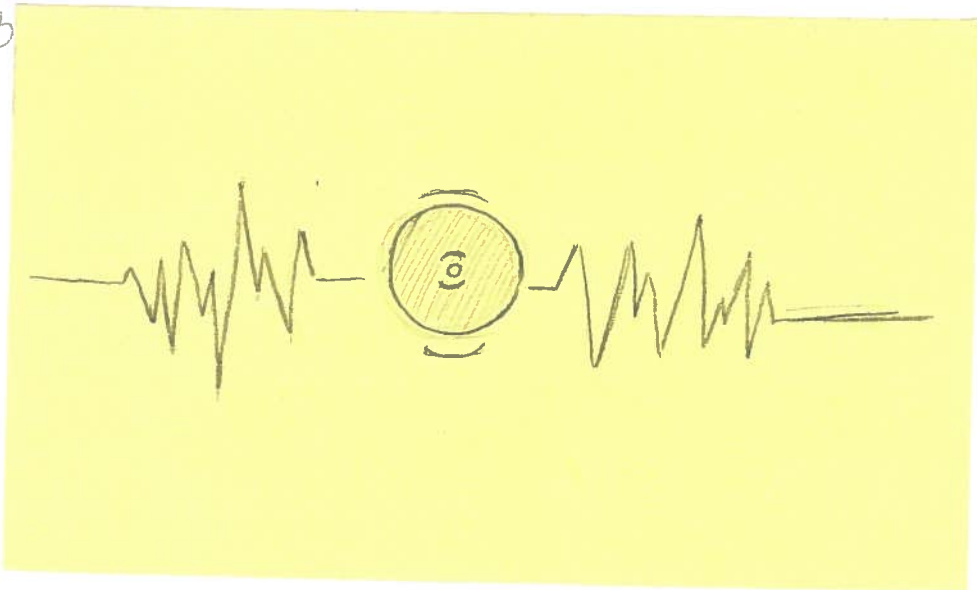


SFX: \*Ding\*

Full frame CU of computer screen.

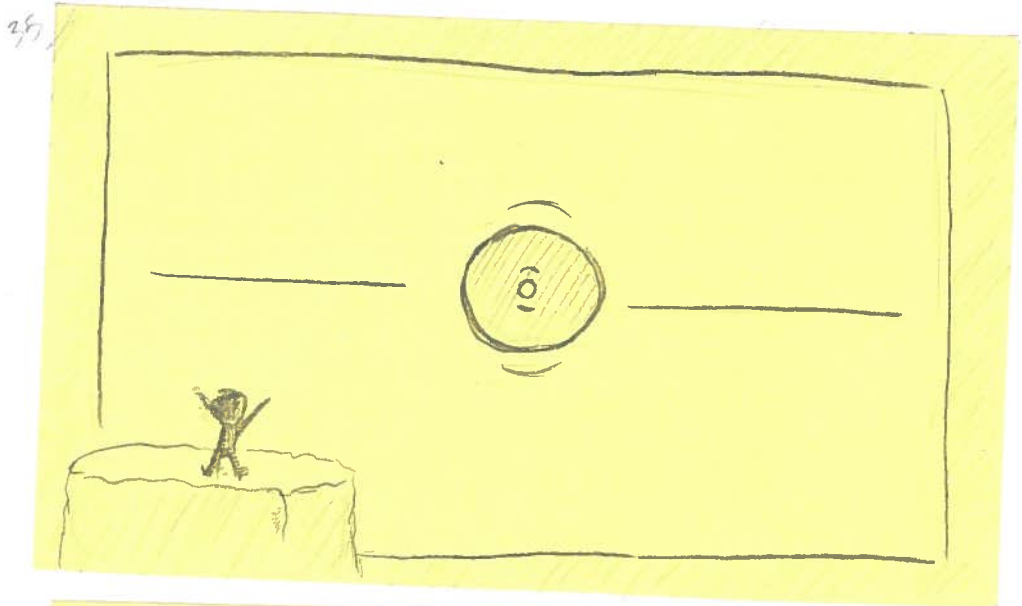

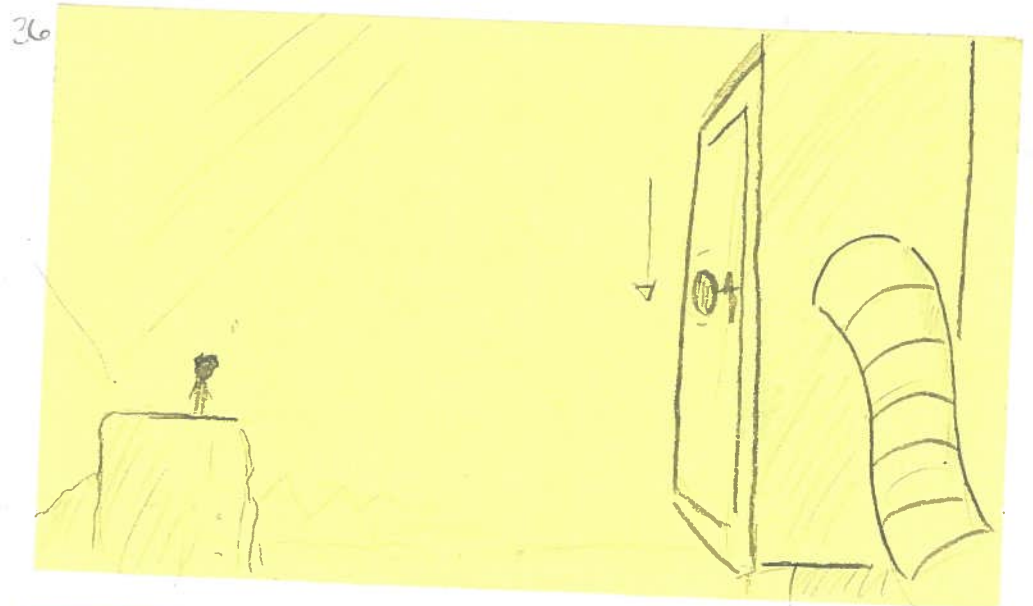
HAM: Of course you have a choice! I'm supposed to be working on a farm back at my colony, but that's not what I want to do.

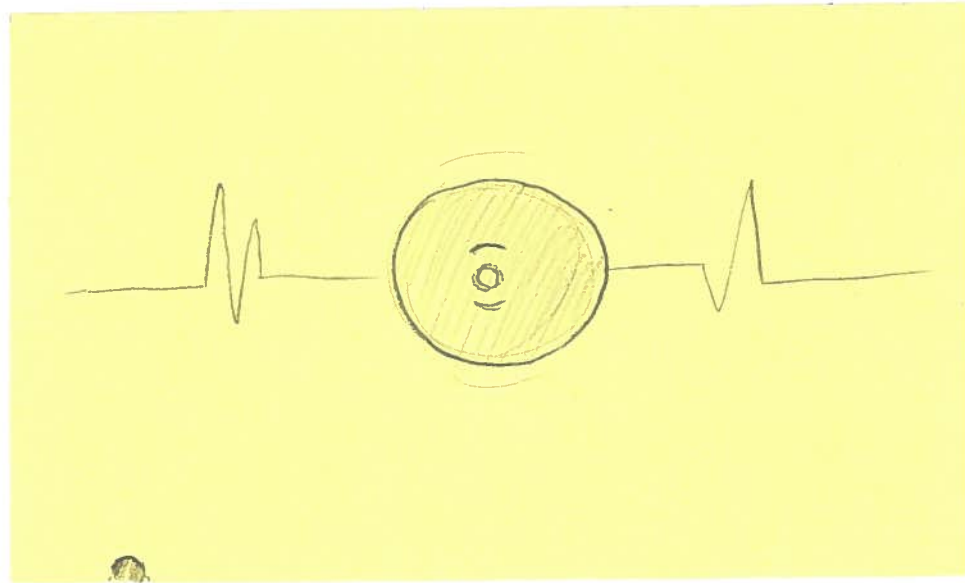
EWS of Ham silhouetted against the giant CPU screen.

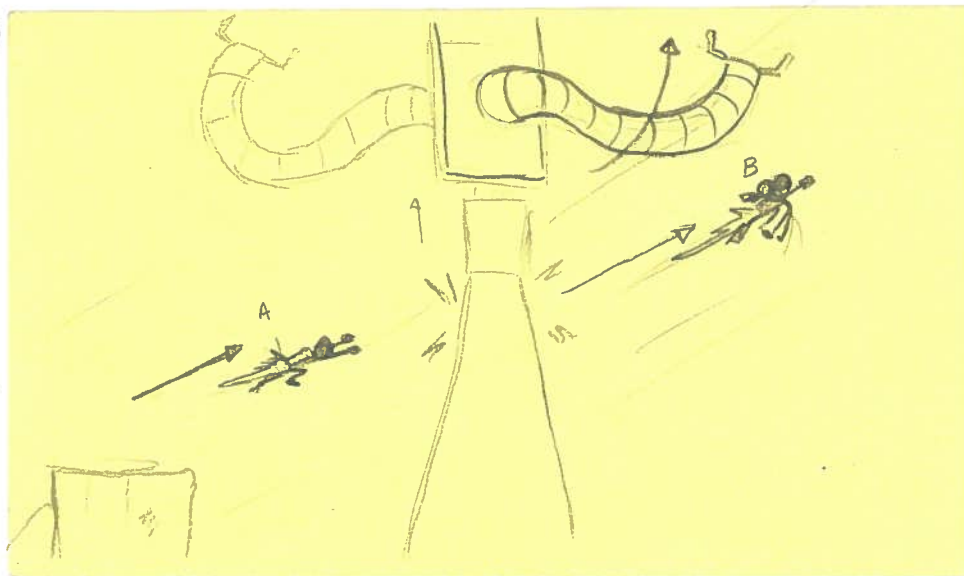

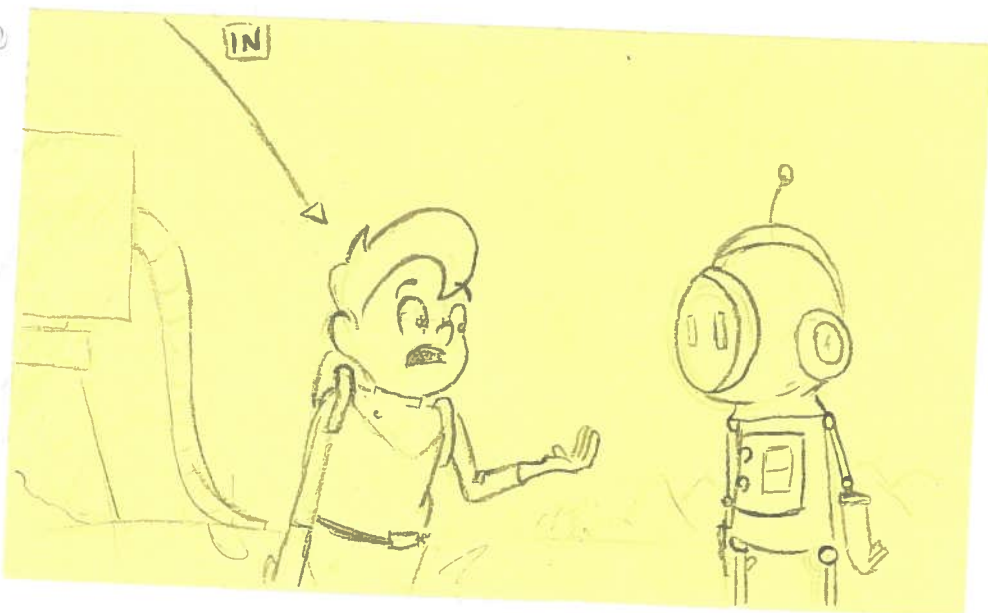

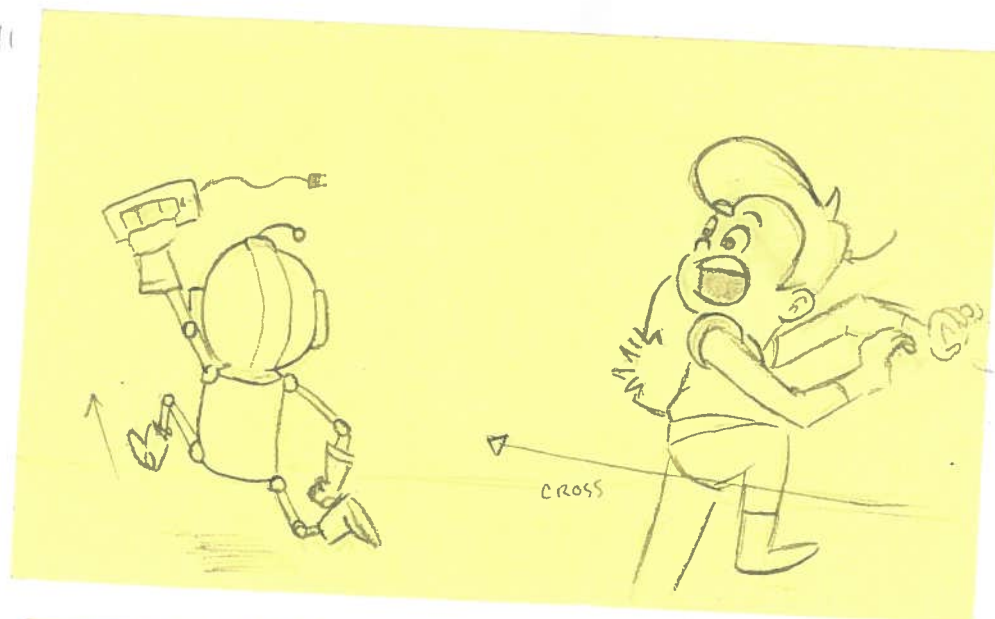
Ham blasts off the plateau and straight through the hole in the CPU. Saving A.I. by disconnecting her from the CPU and stopping the assimilation.

After I gave that speech, I'm kinda sad the computer never got to become a DJ. It made a real breakthrough back there.

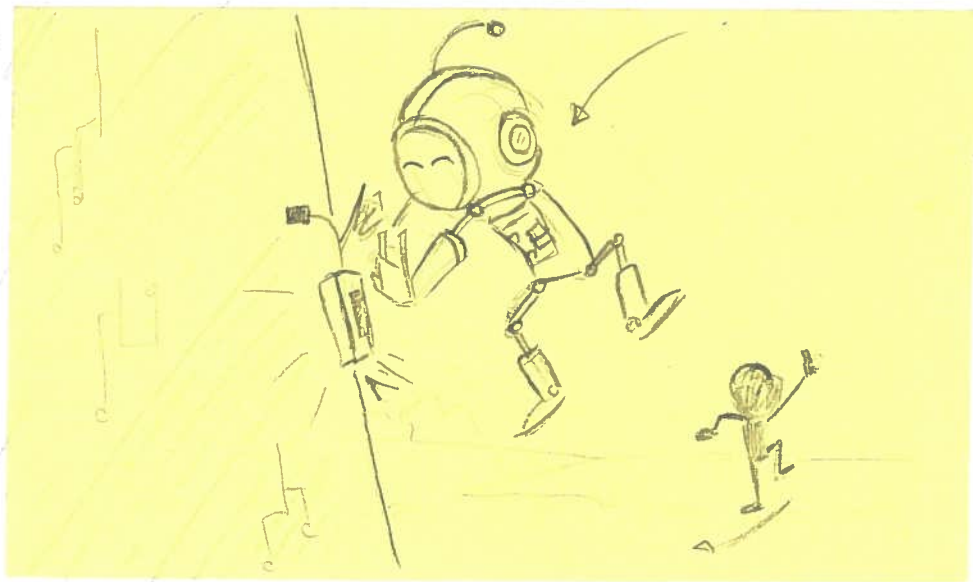
Ham and A.I. land a few yards past the dormant CPU

A.I. thinks for a second, takes his solar battery and runs back toward the dormant CPU

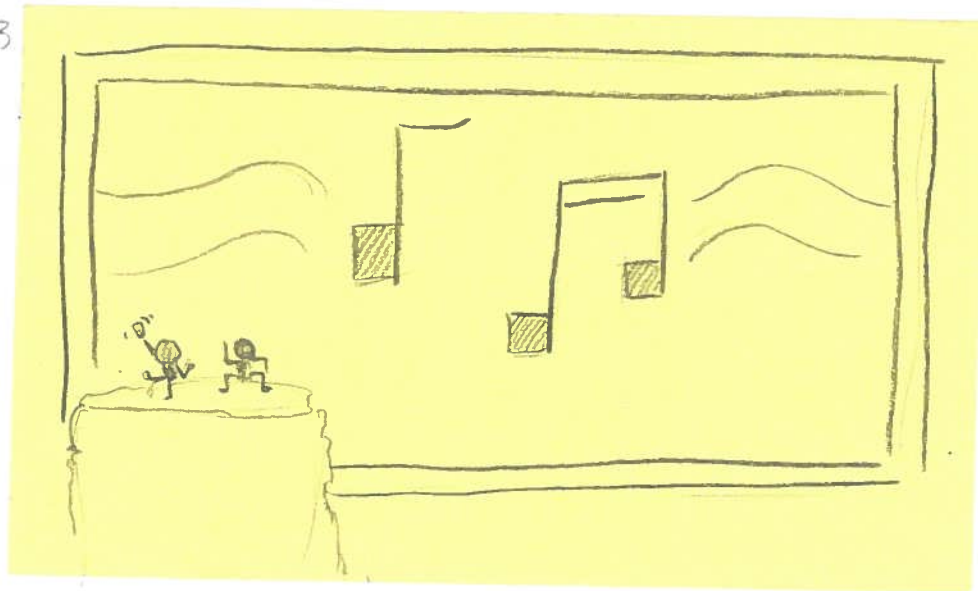
